## ON THE HOB

Sizzle, steam, toast, braise, boil and fry. The ESSE cooktop offers multiple cooking methods. Pots, kettles and heavy based pans can be heated on the hotplate.



## ON THE BBQ GRILL

Handmade in Britain by a team of dedicated craftsmen, Garden Stove combines tradition and practicality. With the hotplate down it can be used to heat a kettle or pans. Once the wood has burnt down to embers, with the hotplate up, Garden Stove offers a barbecue grill.

Designed to burn wood logs of up to 400mm (15inch) in length, the ESSE Garden Stove is supplied complete with 1500mm fluepipe, to promote smoke-free enjoyment of your fire. Once cooled and cleaned, the Garden Stove can be easily wheeled undercover to protect it from the elements.

ESSE Garden Stove is constructed from UK steel and UK cast parts. It is finished with a high temperature paint designed for stoves, barbecues and chimineas. We recommend treating the Garden Stove and barbecue grill with flax oil to protect the product.

A stand-out feature on the terrace, nestled in the garden or alongside a shepherd's hut, the ESSE Garden Stove is perfect for luxurious, yet laid back, outdoor living and delicious wood-fired dining escapes.
